What is the Teaching, Educating And Classroom Help (TEACH) Grants Program for MORROW County?

The purpose is to provide grants to teachers and classrooms in Morrow County, Ohio. The grants are intended to assist individual classroom teachers, or small teams of classroom teachers, foster and develop programs, projects, events, or lessons for kindergarten through 12th grade.

What will or will not be considered for funding?

Grants are intended to assist teachers with funding necessary to implement impactful, interesting, stimulating, motivating, innovative or creative programs, projects, events, or lessons in the classroom that are not supported by regular school budgets.

Who is eligible?

Any Morrow County (Ohio) public or private school teacher who instructs children kindergarten through high school is eligible to apply. Grant monies will be awarded to the school district. No grants will be awarded or distributed directly to individuals.

What is the amount of grant funding?



Primary funding for this grant program is provided from the Pillar Credit Union Morrow County Teachers Fund at Marion Community Foundation. Two grants of \$500 each will be awarded. Gifts to increase these funds are welcomed.

What is the application process and deadline?
