FOUNDATION PERFORMANCE

Q3 2023 saw a reversal in markets as a majority of market sectors returned negative performance. The S&P 500 returned -3.3%, while international stocks returned

-2.9%. Interest rates rose across the intermediate part of the yield curve causing a decline in bond markets throughout the quarter (Barclays US Aggregate, -3.2%).


